



CRITICAL SAFETY ITEM

ADS Purchase Order Attachment: *CSI*

- Per a contract or purchase order received by ADS, the item has been marked as a Critical Safety Item.
- Per DFARs Section 252.209.7010 that means: a part *{assembly, installation equipment, launch equipment, recovery equipment, or support equipment}* for a system *{aircraft or aviation weapon}* if the item *{part, assembly, or equipment}* contains a characteristic *{failure, malfunction, or absence of}* which could cause:
 - Catastrophic or critical failure resulting in the loss of, or serious damage to an aircraft or weapon system;
 - An unacceptable risk of personal injury or loss of life; or
 - An un-commanded engine shutdown that jeopardizes safety.

SUPPLIER REQUIREMENTS

- The items will be inspected by the government at the ADS Facility or Supplier Facility as noted on the purchase order.
- If material is shipping to ADS Warehouse the following information will be needed during the inspection and should as such be provided to ADS via e-mail to the ADS Buyer.
 - Manufacturer's Drawing or specification to ensure the items that is received complies
 - Parameters to which the items are tested, such as any specifications, settings, or pressures to which the items should be set or maintained.
 - Testing results showing that the item/s were tested and passed.
- If the material is being shipped from the supplier facility, the Supplier will need to schedule a DCMA inspection prior to release of shipment. The above material will need to be provided to the Government Inspector
